She has served as Outreach Medical Director, Gynecologic Division, Kaleida Health Laboratories; Assistant Medical Director, Fetal Screening Program, Kaleida Health Laboratory; and Clinical Assistant Professor, Department of Gynecology-Obstetrics, University at Buffalo, School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences. She has practiced obstetrics and gynecology both in academic and private settings in the past.
